### Sporting Clays

Sporting clay shooting is the newest clay target sport. Clay targets are thrown at various angles and distances to challenge the shooter's skill. It combines skill and reflexes to create a competitive sport.

### 5-Stand

A modified version of sporting clays, 5-stand target shooting consists of 5 targets per round. Shooters rotate between 5 positions and targets are thrown from 10 different stations to create a complex pattern.

### International Trap & Skeet

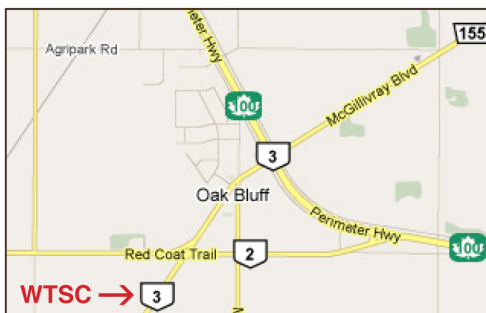
The Winnipeg Trap & Skeet Club is host to both international trap and international skeet programs. For more information visit the club.



### Location

We are located on Highway #3 just south of the Perimeter Highway.

- Take the south Perimeter Highway to McGillivray Boulevard/Highway #3
- Head west on Highway #3 through the town of Oak Bluff
- The club will be on your left, shortly past the junction at Highway #2



### Trap

Trap shooting presents clay targets thrown from the trap "house" directly in front of the shooter on the ground. Targets fly upwards and away from the shooter in various directions from 5 different positions. One round consists of 25 targets.

Trap shooting offers a great environment for new shooters.

### Skeet

"Skeet" derives from a Scandinavian word meaning "to shoot." It is a target shooting sport that unites the skill and thrill of hunting while using clay targets. Targets are thrown from high and low "houses" as shooters move from 8 positions in a semi-circle pattern.

Skeet shooting offers a dynamic environment for shooters of all skill levels.



### History

The Winnipeg Trap & Skeet Club was founded in 1965 by a dedicated group of shooting enthusiasts who believed in building a safety-first club that promoted clay target sports.

Since then the club has grown to operate a 20-acre facility offering sporting clays, trap, skeet, international, and 5-stand shooting.

WTSC was the venue for the Pan American Games in 1967 and 1999.
