The Manitoba Junior Shotgun Provincials (MJSA) are this **Sunday June 27**, 2010 at the Lakeshore Gun Club, Lundar Manitoba. Map to Gun Club is available tonight. Lundar is about one hour north of Winnipeg on Highway #6. Registration is between 9:30 and 10:00 am. The event should conclude by 4pm.

In the past this event has been very successful because of strong representation by our club. If you can attend it will be very much appreciated by MJSA and myself.

The event is a 100 target event. The entry fee is one book of MJSA raffle tickets and this gets you the targets, 4 boxes of shells, lunch and trophies.

All raffle tickets should be turned in tonight or bring them to Lundar if you are attending.

Next **Monday night (June 28)** is our last night for the program this year. We will have a wind-up with food, refreshments and prizes (Only Juniors eligible for prizes). The menu will be rye bread, cold cuts, chips, cheese, pickles and dessert. Parents/grandparents are invited and encouraged to shoot this evening if they wish. We will have a variety of targets to (hopefully) include skeet, trap, international trap and the popular turkey shoot. The cost of supper will be whatever you wish to donate (small donation to offset).
