

**President's note:**

This will be the last ShotString of the year.

The Annual General Meeting will take place Dec 5, 2010 at 1:00 in the Sport Manitoba building, 145 Pacific Avenue. This will be a very important meeting, please plan on attending. The announcement of meeting was either emailed or mailed to all current members in good standing. **New Fall/Winter hours:**

**Token Machines:**

**Manitoba Trapshooting Association (MTA):**

On Sunday October 31<sup>st</sup> Louise Curé, Gerri Gerow and myself attended the Manitoba Trapshooting Association (MTA) executive meeting (9:30 am to 11:30 am), followed by the Annual General Meeting (1:30 pm to 3:30 pm). We three attend the regularly scheduled meetings throughout the year. Louise represents WTSC trap, Gerri is a Director at Large and I represent International trap. This meeting is important for two reasons, firstly cheques are given out for programs that the various clubs run through-out the year and MTA pays the clubs back: Try it you'll like it, leagues, trophy costs: junior programs...and secondly because the clubs in Manitoba pick the dates for the tournaments for the new year. Since WTSC is the largest club and we do the most, our cheque is larger.

MTA receives money from Sport Manitoba in the form of bingos and operating funds. The clubs provide the manpower to work the bingos and in turn the funds are equally distributed to the clubs. The operating funds are used to run MTA programs.
