5-Stand/Sporting Clays:

- A permanent 5-stand (compact sporting clays) course on skeet field #2 is available any time the club is open.
- For more information, call Tom Hancock at 204.981.4251.

Some Five-stand notes that will make your shooting experience more enjoyable:

- No tokens are required. Swipe your card in the skeet field reader, or have the puller/trap boy do it for you.
- Try to shoot as a squad of 5.
- Squads must be a minimum of 3 people.
- When it is your squad's turn, be ready to take the stands.
- While you are waiting, locate and watch the targets. The machines are always numbered the same 1 through 8, just not all are used on any given day.
- Locate the traps for your station before it is your turn to shoot.
- No "Show me that again!"
- If you are new to 5-stand, ask the puller to give you singles only.
- Do not adjust clay target throwers.
- No repeats.
- Do not change chokes once a round has started.
- Keep it fast-moving and fun!

International Trap:

- Weather permitting, the south bunker is open Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday nights, from 5:30 until dusk.
- Work has begun on the privately-funded cover over the south bunker's shooting stations. Once completed, it will be the only covered bunker in western Canada. Thanks to **Robert** of **Target Construction** for the use of his skid steer and his considerable operating expertise.

Ammunition policy:

- PrairieShot, the makers of Score Ammunition, is the exclusive provider of ammunition to the WTSC. Ammunition will be available for purchase by members, used in the MJSA Junior Program, and will be provided to all corporate/group events.
- The WTSC ammunition policy is as follows: lead shot only, and no shot larger than 71/2. If you are shooting on a trap or skeet field and notice either a member or non-member shooting inappropriate ammunition, please bring it to the attention of the Club Manager. Steel shot should never be used on the sporting fields, since it can ricochet, and hurt the shooter and those around him/her. Steel shot should never be used on the steel patterning plate. It is dangerous, and will ruin the patterning plate.

Clubhouse Improvements:

- Kevin and I undertook some minor renovations in the main clubhouse prior to the shooting season. A new snack and beverage area has been created to house the snack machine. It features a selection of chips (\$0.75) and chocolate bars (\$1.25), and a new drink-vending machine in which WTSC-labeled water is available for a loonie, and pop for a toonie per bottle.
- We have Tom to thank for scrubbing the kitchen so vigorously that it passed government inspection last month. Many thanks for your efforts on this front Tom.
